Hawaiian Training Vacation April 1 - 7, 2012

From April 1-7, 2012, the Flight Academy will host a 7-day Cirrus training program at the beautiful Royal Lahaina Resort in Maui, Hawaii. You will be able to choose a Flight and Ground course or Ground course only. With the Flight and Ground course, you fly one full day with a Flight Academy Platinum Training Center instructor doing recurrent training, focusing on areas of training that you would like to work on while exploring the Hawaiian Islands. In addition to the flying, you are invited to attend our evening events, including a Luau and our three ground school seminars.

The three ground seminars are:

Fundamentals of Flight-

Focusing on the foundations of good VFR and IFR flight skills. We will be discussing in detail the phases of approach, flare, touchdown and landing. What is important and what is not. How to make a safe, soft, landing each time; and the aerodynamics and mechanics that make this happen.

In the same seminar, we will be discussing specific instrument approaches and how to properly brief, load, and set-up for an approach including proper power settings and autopilot inputs, including the missed approach and holding phases.

Lastly, we will cover Emergency checklists and Memory items. Learn the must know things that will keep you and your family safe if you find yourself in an emergency.

Engine Management and iPad-

This seminar will focus on engine management techniques. What is LOP and why do we feel it is the best way to operate your engine. Why does operating LOP not only keep my temperature down but reduce pressure in the cylinders? Find out what the original aviators knew and then was forgotten.

We will also cover iPad use and Foreflight in this seminar. Technology is giving pilots more information than we can handle. Learn some tricks and techniques for using this tool and also what phases of flight we feel are best for the iPad.

Accident Review and Scenario Based Decision Making-

Review Cirrus accidents in-depth and understand the causes and what we have learned from them. The first part of this seminar focuses on the facts and circumstances of Cirrus accidents.

The second part of the seminar focuses on decision-making. It is too easy to write off the accidents by saying "I would never do that". The Flight Academy will lead you through a real world scenario to get you to evaluate your decision making skills each step of the way. You might be surprised at what you discover.
